

## **Jewish Programming Continues on NET Television**

LINCOLN, Neb. (March 31, 2010) -- NET Television continues its broadcast of programs honoring Jewish heritage and traditions during National Holocaust Month with several specials during the next few weeks.

**“The Diary of Anne Frank,”** a new adaptation of the moving account of life hiding from the Nazis airs on **“Masterpiece Classic”** on Holocaust Remembrance Day, Sunday, April 11, at 8 p.m. CT on NET1 and in high-definition on NET-HD.

The series **“The Jewish Americans”** continues with **“The Best of Times, The Worst of Times,”** Sunday, April 11, at 10 p.m. CT on NET1 and NET-HD, covering the early 20th century, when Anti-Semitism was on the rise even as some Jews succeeded in mainstream pursuits. The concluding episode, **“Home,”** airs Sunday, April 18, at 10 p.m. CT and explores the post-war period, when discrimination against Jews in daily life began to abate and Jews entered professions such as medicine, law and banking in record numbers.

Did any Arabs save Jews during the Holocaust? Robert Satloff, head of a respected Washington policy center, spent eight years on a journey to find an Arab whose story would change the way Arabs view Jews, themselves and their own history. **“Among the Righteous: Lost Stories from the Holocaust in Arab Lands”** airs Monday, April 12, at 9 p.m. CT on NET1 and in high-definition on NET-HD. It is followed at 10 p.m. CT by **“House of Life: The Old Jewish Cemetery in Prague,”** featuring interviews with curators, historians, rabbis, guides and conservationists devoted to the preservation of Prague’s Old Jewish Cemetery.

**“Blessed is the Match,”** airing on **“Independent Lens”** on Tuesday, April 13, at 11 p.m. on NET1 and in high-definition on NET-HD, is a documentary about Hannah Senesh, a World War II-era poet and diarist who became a paratrooper and resistance fighter and was captured, tortured and ultimately executed by the Nazis.

The truth about the Auschwitz death camp was one of the most closely guarded secrets of the Third Reich. **“Escape From Auschwitz,”** airing on **“Secrets of the Dead”** on Thursday, April 15, at 10 p.m. CT on NET1 and NET-HD, tells the story of two young Slovak Jews who managed to escape by hiding in a woodpile for three days, then fleeing across enemy territory.
