

KRNE-TV Temporarily Off the Air Due to Antenna Problems

LINCOLN, Neb. (April 7, 2008) -- NET Television's KRNE Channel 12 analog channel in the Merriman area is off the air until further notice due to an antenna problem. This outage does not affect the Merriman digital television signal on Channel 17, nor does it affect cable television service.

The KRNE coverage area includes the communities of Merriman, Gordon, Rushville, Hay Springs, Ellsworth, Bingham, Ashby, Hyannis, Whitman, Mullen, Crookston, Kilgore, Nenzel and Cody. Residents in the Valentine area may be affected, although transmitter KMNE Channel 7 in Bassett is more likely to be the primary signal in that area.

NET Assistant General Manager for Technology Services Stacey Decker assures NET Television viewers that, "Our engineers are assessing the situation and hope to have analog service in the Merriman area restored as soon as possible."
