

## **Nebraska & Creighton Featured in Baseball Action on NET Television**

LINCOLN, Neb. (April 7, 2010) -- The hardballs could be screaming over stadium fences with Big 12 Conference and intrastate competitions featured this week on NET Television.

The Kansas Jayhawks collide with Mike Anderson's Huskers at Lincoln's Hawks Field on "Nebraska Baseball" airing Sunday, April 18, at 1 p.m. CT on NET1 and in high-definition on NET-HD.

Then the Huskers travel I-80 east to face-off against the Creighton Bluejays at Omaha's Rosenblatt Stadium when "Nebraska vs. Creighton Baseball" airs Tuesday, April 20, at 6:30 p.m. on NET1 and in high-definition on NET-HD.

Sportscaster Kevin Kugler calls the play-by-play action for both games, with Adrian Fiala providing color commentary for the Kansas/Nebraska game and John Bishop offering analysis for the Nebraska/Creighton match-up.
