

Nebraska & Creighton Featured in Baseball Action on NET Television

LINCOLN, Neb. (May 5, 2010) -- NET Television closes out its 2010 collegiate baseball coverage with two games scheduled this week for broadcast on NET1 and in high-definition NET-HD.

Intrastate rivals Nebraska and Creighton meet for the third time this season, with the Huskers hoping to end their losing streak against the Bluejays. "Nebraska vs. Creighton Baseball" is broadcast live from Omaha's Rosenblatt Stadium on Tuesday, May 18, at 7 p.m. CT.

On Saturday, May 22, Texas Tech visits Nebraska's Hawks Field to take on the Huskers in Big 12 Conference action on "Nebraska Baseball" at 2 p.m. CT.

Sportscaster Kevin Kugler calls the play-by-play action for both games, with John Bishop providing color commentary and Larry Puntene handling sidelines reports for the Nebraska/Creighton game. Adrian Fiala offers the color analysis for Texas Tech vs. Nebraska.
