

Reprise of Most Popular Segments on “Best of Nebraska Stories”

LINCOLN, Neb. (May 19, 2010) -- Some of the most popular segments from “Nebraska Stories” -- NET Television’s monthly series of compelling, personal tales of Nebraskans and Nebraska life -- are presented in the special “Best of Nebraska Stories,” airing Tuesday, June 1, at 8 p.m. CT on NET1 and in high-definition on NET-HD.

These distinctive segments include the story of Nebraska veterans participating in “honor flights” to Washington, D.C., as well as a portrait of Nebraska’s football walk-on program and one of its most legendary recruits.

Also featured is a look at an East German artist creating nostalgic and surreal art in Lincoln; calving season during the coldest time of the year; and a visit to Bellevue’s Fontenelle Forest, one of the largest private nature centers in the country.

“Best of Nebraska Stories” will repeat on NET1 and NET-HD on Sunday, June 6, at noon CT; Sunday, June 20, at 9:30 p.m. CT; Tuesday, June 22, at 11:30 p.m. CT; and Saturday, June 26, at 10:30 p.m. CT. It can also be seen on NET2 on Wednesday, June 23, at 6 p.m. CT; Sunday, June 27, at 8:30 a.m. CT; and Monday, June 28, at 7:30 p.m. CT.
