

Premiere Screenings of NET Television Film “Walk Ons: Huskers’ Edge” in Omaha July 30

LINCOLN, Neb. (July 15, 2009) -- NET Television will kick off the football tailgating season with a premiere of its upcoming, high-definition documentary “Walk Ons: Huskers’ Edge” on Thursday, July 30, at Marcus Village Point Cinema, (304 North 174th Street), in Omaha.
