

Lopers/Mavericks Football Live on NET Television

LINCOLN, Neb. (Aug. 18, 2010) -- Intrastate NCAA Division II football rivals the University of Nebraska at Kearney (UNK) Antelopes and the University of Nebraska at Omaha (UNO) Mavericks face off on “UNK vs. UNO Football,” airing Saturday, Sept. 4, at 6 p.m. CT on NET1 and in high definition on NET-HD.

Telecast live from UNO’s Al Caniglia Field, sportscaster Larry Puntaney will provide play-by-play, with former Husker Damon Benning offering color analysis. Jon Tritsch will provide sideline reports during the game.

The Lopers are the pre-season pick to win the Rocky Mountain Athletic Conference title, with the Mavericks the pre-season number two pick in the Mid-America Intercollegiate Athletic Association Conference.

The football game will also be webcast live on NET’s website (netNebraska.org). All that is needed is access to the Internet and a free Windows Media Player program. Webcasting of the program is a free service of NET.
