

Maverick/Loper Football Broadcast Live on NET Television

LINCOLN, Neb. (Aug. 19, 2009) -- The University of Nebraska at Omaha (UNO) Mavericks and the University of Nebraska at Kearney (UNK) Lopers square off against each other in a gridiron match-up on Saturday, Sept. 5, with the contest broadcast live on NET1 and in high-definition on NET-HD.

With kick-off scheduled at noon CT, the two intrastate rivals will take to Foster Field at UNK's Cope Stadium to settle the contest, with sportscaster Larry Puntaney and former Husker football standout Damon Benning providing play-by-play and color analysis. Sideline interviews will be provided by Kearney newscaster Seth Denney.

The football game will also be webcast live on NET's Web site (netNebraska.org). All that is needed is access to the Internet and a free Windows Media Player program. Webcasting of the series is a free service of NET.
