

## **NET Television Receives Award from Project Extra Mile for "Your Kids Are Drinking"**

LINCOLN, Neb. (Sept. 2, 2009) -- NET Television will receive the Media Award of Excellence from Project Extra Mile at their 10th annual recognition dinner on Sept. 24. Project Extra Mile is a statewide network of community coalitions in Nebraska working to prevent underage drinking.

NET Television's production "Your Kids Are Drinking," which first aired in September 2008, explores how lax attitudes among adults aggravate the youth drinking problem and corresponding ways that adults can provide realistic solutions. NET's Bill Kelly and Perry Stoner produced and wrote the program, which is being used across the state to educate kids, parents and teachers about this chronic problem.
