

## Nebraskan Dennis Brouse Hosts “Saddle Up” Series Airing on NET Television

LINCOLN, Neb. (Sept. 9, 2009) -- The relationship between horse and human is celebrated in the 13-part series “Saddle Up with Dennis Brouse,” airing Sundays at 8:30 a.m. CT on NET2, beginning Sept. 20.

Series host and Nebraska resident Dennis Brouse is a highly respected and experienced horse trainer who has been working with horses since the age of 14.

According to Brouse, the series will appeal to everyone from the serious horse owner to the arm-chair rider. “Whether you own a horse or just love to watch them in the movies, the programs will explore our storied partnership with this magnificent animal,” he said.

Each 30-minute episode will showcase a specific training question or situation addressed by Brouse with the horse’s owner. Special features will take viewers on powerful and emotional journeys into the horse world, highlighting everything from the mounted police to hippotherapy, along with segments on special breeds and classes of horses.

After spending time learning to train horses “the old fashioned way,” he quickly realized that he was at odds with that method. Since 1996, Brouse has spent thousands of hours studying and fine-tuning his training methods.
