

## **NET Radio's "Nebraska Concerts" in October Features Performances from Lincoln, Hastings and Omaha**

LINCOLN, Neb. (Sept. 21, 2009) -- This month "Nebraska Concerts" takes listeners to the movies with Lincoln's Symphony Orchestra, then to Hastings with pianist Joel Fan, then to the River City for a performance from the Omaha Symphony Chamber Orchestra, and back to Lincoln with the Ying Quartet. NET Radio's weekly series of fine music performed and recorded on Nebraska's stages airs Sundays at 2 p.m. CT.

On Sunday, Oct. 4, Lincoln's Symphony Orchestra offers up selections from favorite film scores with a program called "LSO at the Movies." Featured are familiar melodies from Ponchielli, Barber, Dukas, Tchaikovsky, along with several John Williams compositions. Edward Polochick conducts, and concertmaster Anton Miller provides the violin for selections from "Schindler's List."

The program on Sunday, Oct. 11, features pianist Joel Fan, who was a featured artist in the 2008 Meadowlark Music Festival. He returned to Nebraska in 2009 for a fundraiser for the Meadowlark Festival and for a concert with the Hastings Symphony Orchestra. The Oct. 11 program provides highlights from both performances.

A performance by the Omaha Symphony Chamber Orchestra is featured on Sunday, Oct. 18, from their 2008/2009 season. Guest conductor Andrew Grams leads the group in two Schoenberg compositions as well as Haydn's Symphony No. 49 in F Minor, "La passione." Cellist Paul Ledwon is the featured cellist for Tchaikovsky's "Variations on a Rococo Theme" for Cello and Orchestra, Op. 33.

And in the final concert of the month on Sunday, Oct. 25, the Ying Quartet performs string quartets by Mendelssohn, Bartok and Dvorak in a performance from the Lincoln Friends of Chamber Music's 2008/2009 season finale.

"Nebraska Concerts" is broadcast on NET Radio, a service of NET. Dave Hughes is producer and Genevieve Randall is scriptwriter and host. The Omaha Symphony concert was recorded by Clete Baker of Studio B for Classical 90.7, KVNO.
