

Tune in to NET Radio's "Nebraska Concerts" in January for Classical Music

LINCOLN, Neb. (Dec. 19, 2007) -- In January "Nebraska Concerts" offers performances by Lincoln's Symphony Orchestra, the Imani Winds and the Chiara Quartet. The weekly NET Radio series of fine music performed and recorded on Nebraska's stages airs Sundays at 2 p.m. CT.

The "Nebraska Concerts" program on Sunday, Jan. 6, is taken from an Abendmusik: Lincoln concert by Imani Winds. This young ensemble with members of African American and Latin American heritage explores the links between European, African and American music traditions.

On Sunday, Jan. 13, the "Russian Heartstrings" concert from Lincoln's Symphony features concertmaster Anton Miller in Serge Prokofiev's "Violin Concerto #2 in G Minor." Also, on the program is Mikhail Glinka's "Russlan and Ludmilla: Overture" and Piotor Tchaikovsky's "Symphony #4 in F Minor."

The Sunday, Jan. 20, concert features the University of Nebraska-Lincoln artists-in-residence, the Chiara Quartet, in a Lincoln Friends of Chamber Music concert from November 2006. The group joined clarinetist Hakan Rosengren to perform Brahms's Clarinet Quintet, Op. 115. The quartet also played the Brahms String Quartet, Op. 67, at this concert which was part of the group's year-long celebration of the music of Brahms.

Lincoln's Symphony Orchestra presents a program on Sunday, Jan. 27, entitled "Solos & Celebration." Flutist John Bailey and harpist Kathleen Wychulis perform Mozart's "Concerto for Flute & Harp in C Major, K.299," with the orchestra. Also on the program is Mozart's Overture from "The Abduction from the Seraglio" and Richard Strauss's "Le Bourgeois Gentilhomme Suite, Op. 60."

"Nebraska Concerts" is broadcast on NET Radio, a service of NET. Dave Hughes is producer and Genevieve Randall is scriptwriter and host.
